Broker's Comments:

The Hallberg-Rassy 62 is an evergreen bluewater cruising yacht, which is equally comfortable in Northern waters as it is in the Tropics. CONTRARIAN is equipped for both with 2 central heating systems as well as air conditioning and an easy to manage push button cutter rig. She has a warm traditional mahogany interior with teak and holly soleboards that have been covered since launch, so they look new. Her versatile layout with three guest cabins and enormous aft owners' stateroom means that she works equally well as an owner-driver yacht or with crew.

She has been substantially upgraded for relaxed serious cruising in this ownership and she is only now offered for sale as her owner has purchased a larger yacht and wishes to reduce his fleet.

Owner's Comments:

Firstly this is a gorgeous yacht to sail and I love the way she handles herself in a good breeze. She absolutely crushes though moderate waves and upwind is a delight.

At 20 knots or so you can still keep the big Genny up and full main and the yacht will do 9 – 10 knots.

At 30 – 40 knots you run the smaller cutter sail and a reefed main and she handles very well there too, with little roll and no hobby horsing.

The hard dodger is great both for wind and sun, and on cold passages, we usually sit under that with the boat on auto pilot. We added a bimini, which is great for sun protection and we leave that up even in 25 knot wind.

In harbour or at anchor the layout is great and the kitchen works well, I have entertained groups of 6 -8 with no problem, and cooked fantastic meals.

The new electric davits are great. We have a RIB with 35hp motor and we can get that in the water and ready in minutes. That is perfect for getting ashore at high speed to pick people up or go to market etc.

Everything works perfectly, and we changed out all appliances and most pumps and chargers, so most of the gear works like new, watermaker, AC, cooker etc.

We have sailed her all around in the Med and at first around the Solent. Most recently we were in the Balearics, Sardinia, Spain, Gibraltar, one season in Canaries, in Tenerife, then to Madeira and then to Greece. We were in Corfu for the last 6 months of the season this year.

In bigger seas she is very stable, and in a squall she is slow to roll down, so easy to manage. In flat seas she cruises at 8 knots and in moderate sea more like 7 knots. In light air we usually motor sail and run at around 7.5 knots.

The boat is designed for a couple to sail, and you can certainly do that. I usually sail with just my skipper and one or two friends, but they don't need to do anything. When I first bought the yacht I went sailing a couple of times in the Solent just on my own and it was quite easy to sail solo, and also quite easy to dock, although doing that solo takes a bit of practice. But two people can handle that no problem.

Construction:

RCD Status: The yacht conforms with the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC or RCDII (2013/53/EU as appropriate (Recreational Craft Directive) and is categorised A – "Ocean".

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- Hand lay-up method with woven rovings, isophthalic polyester and isophthalic gelcoat, colour number white 1000.
- The hull is insulated from 20 cm under the water line up with Divinycell PVC foam core.
- There is a decorative blue stripe in gelcoat.

- A rubbing strake with stainless strip situated below the blue stripe.
- The underwater hull is painted with two coats of epoxy primer and two coats of antifouling.
- Blue double water line.
- Built-in longitudinal and athwartships stiffener.
- Well maintained teak deck.
- Hallberg Rassy hard top at forward of cockpit.
- The underwater profile of CONTRARIAN will be stripped and re-primed and antifouled by the owner prior to any sale.

Keel & Rudder:

- Lead keel bolted on with 14 M36 stainless steel keel bolts.
- Keel bolts are accessible without moving the tanks.
- Also the deep bilge is easily accessible.
- The Rudder in GRP, rudder shaft 100 mm stainless steel.
- Heavy cast bronze rudder fittings.
- High class roller bearings.
- Keel bolts tightened and secured.
- Rudder bearing and packing on main shaft.

Description of layout from forwards:

There is a spacious double cabin for crew with lots of storage and with a large hatch for access onto the deck. There is a door from this cabin to a heads compartment with a separated shower stall. This is shared by two large forward cabins. The port forward guest cabin has a double berth with lots of storage and its own heads leading into the shared shower stall. The port guest cabin is an ample upper and lower berth cabin.

Both guest cabins have doors into the main saloon. This has a large U-shaped dining area with an additional return sofa amidships providing comfortable seating for at least eight people. There is a flat screen TV on the port bulkhead and to starboard are two easy chairs. Aft of these is a well-equipped galley with electric cooker, twin sink, fridge and freezer space. There is plenty of stowage and workspace and easy access to the cockpit. To port aft is a large chart table and a passageway to the owners' stateroom. This has the access door to the engine room. This has generous access to engine and generator as well as the chargers, power pack and condensers.

The owners' stateroom has 1 double berth and 1 ¾ berth, with a sofa between them and masses of storage. It is very light and airy. There is an en suite heads compartment with separated shower stall.
