NIKITA ex-NORTHERN LIGHT was designed and built for the Commodore of the New York Yacht Club, who wanted an extremely capable, reliable, safe yacht that would comfortably accommodate his family plus guests for extended cruising. Arguably one of America's most experienced yachtsman, his extensive yachting background combined with C.W. Paine Yacht Design and her builders in New Zealand have created a very special yacht that has met all of her owner's requirements. Her capabilities have been well proven including Transatlantic passages with stops in Greenland and Iceland and more than 70,000 miles of troublefree cruising. In addition to her interior being air-conditioned and heated, there is plenty of natural ventilation through numerous screened hatches and portholes. One of her many special features is her electrical system which permits the vessel to operate silently overnight even without her exceedingly quiet generator. She has enjoyed meticulous professional maintenance which is reflected in her present condition and she is ready for her next voyage. NIKITA retuned to Europe spring 2013 where she spent three seasons in the Mediterranean and in Northern Europe. She returned to South Florida at the end of November to be totally prepared for sale in turn key condition only because her owner has purchased a larger yacht.

Accommodations

Accommodations include four double staterooms designed to provide ample space for owners, guests and crew for extended cruising.

Starting on the aft deck you will find a small L-shaped settee in the starboard aft corner and a large L-shaped settee to port with a varnished teak cocktail dining table. Between these two settees there is a transom gate and stairway to the swim platform. There is also a hidden set of controls and a capstan for docking or stern anchoring. On the forward bulkhead of this area is a beautiful etched glass window. Just below there is a wet bar with icemaker, beverage / wine cooler, and storage. A door to port provides entry to the saloon.

Immediately to port is an oilskin locker which also serves as emergency engine room egress. To port in the saloon there is an L-shaped settee with cocktail table. To starboard a semi C-shaped settee with a custom designed dining table that can be lowered for cocktails. Like every other area of the yacht, there is more than ample storage space. The large windows in the saloon provide excellent visibility while seated. A Sony AM/FM with CD player; Panasonic TV, JVC DVD player and KVH track vision antenna are built into cabinets.

Going below from the saloon down a few steps you will find yourself in a small passageway. To starboard is the 4th stateroom / crews' quarters with fore and aft double berth, a Pullman single, hanging lockers, dresser and miscellaneous lockers. Opposite to port is a head for that stateroom, which includes vanity, sink, shower and storage lockers.

Moving forward from the passageway is the full-width owner's stateroom. It features a queen berth, ample locker/drawer space, a built-in desk and bookcases, ensuite head with stall shower. This stateroom can be accessed from the wheelhouse along with the other staterooms, or separately from the saloon.

Forward of the owner's stateroom there is a guest upper and lower stateroom with hanging lockers and this cabin is serviced by a head and stall shower to starboard.

All the way forward is the VIP stateroom with queen berth, hanging locker, dresser and miscellaneous lockers, and has direct access to the head with stall shower.

All staterooms have ample cedar lined hanging lockers, drawers and miscellaneous lockers. The entire interior is cherry paneled and trimmed. The interior is air-conditioned and heated with Cruiseair chilled water reverse cycle system and auxilliary heating of the system is also available through a diesel fueled Hurricane heater.

Moving up to the wheelhouse, which is protected by the Portuguese Bridge, you will find a centerline control station with Stidd helm chair.

To port there is a C-shaped dinette which can be used for cocktails and informal dining, or just lounging. This is an ideal vantage point to see the world around with excellent visibility when seated.

There is direct access to the wide side walk from both sides of the wheelhouse through Freeman water tight doors. From the starboard forward side of the wheelhouse a stairway leads down to the staterooms. Aft there is a stairway leading below from the saloon.

A stairway leads from the wheelhouse up to the boat deck and flybridge. The centerline helm on the bridge duplicates all the important instrumentation, as well as electronics that are in the wheelhouse. There are Stidd helmsman and companion seats new in 2009 as well as an L-shaped settee with varnished teak table.

The interior bulkhead doors and trim are finished in rubbed effect varnished cherry with beautiful joinerwork. Heads are finished with Corian counters and Awlgrip paint and have exhaust fans. The entire interior is heated and air-conditioned, as well as having plenty of natural air through screened hatches, ports and Dorade vents. Throughout the interior and exterior every effort was made to create as much storage space as possible. All staterooms have telephone and computer hook-ups.
